PLANNED *Gifts*

GIFTS OF RETIREMENT ASSETS

When you name the Foundation of the ATS as the beneficiary of your IRA, 401(k) or other qualified plan, any residual left in your plan when you die passes to the Foundation tax free. CHARITABLE GIFT ANNUITIES

The charitable gift annuity offers payment rates well above prevailing interest rates yielded by certificates of deposit, money market funds and savings bank accounts. The payment rates are determined by donors' ages—the older the person, the higher the payment. A portion of each payment is tax free and donors are entitled to an immediate income tax deduction for the contribution they make.

CHARITABLE REMAINDER TRUSTS

To establish the trust, donors may transfer cash, securities or other property. The trust makes payments to the donor (and spouse, for example) for their lifetime. When the trust ends, the principal passes to the Foundation. Donors receive an immediate tax deduction for a portion of their contribution to the trust and pay no capital gains tax on the appreciated assets they donated.

CHARITABLE LEAD TRUST

To establish the trust, donors may contribute cash, securities or other property. The trust makes payments to the Foundation for a specific number of years, after which the remaining principal goes to the donors' heirs. Donors qualify for a gift tax deduction and savings on their estate taxes.

BEQUESTS: REMEMBERING THE ATS IN YOUR WILL

Your will is an enduring statement to the people, causes and institutions that you care about. Your will says you care enough to make your intentions clear. It leaves no doubt as to your priorities and your convictions. Wills are an important source of support for the ATS. They are often the largest and the easiest planned gift an individual can make. Because they are revocable gifts, they do not jeopardize your cash flow, standard of living or ability to meet future needs. To include the ATS in your bequest, please ask your attorney to write a simple codicil to your existing will.

When including this provision in your will, please use our full legal name: The Foundation of the American Thoracic Society, a non-profit

501(c)(3) corporation. You and your attorney can decide how you can make your bequest commitment. Provided below is sample language for your consideration:

- **Unrestricted Gift:** *A gift that can be used where the need is greatest.*

- **Gift for a Specific Purpose:** *A gift that can be designated.*

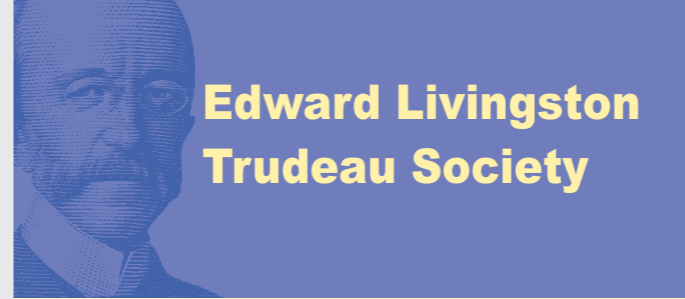

CREATIVE LIFE-INCOME GIFTS IN YOUR WILL

Donors may transfer cash, stock, real estate, artwork, IRAs, pension benefits and closely held stock, among other assets, to the Foundation through their will. There is no upper limit on the estate tax deduction that a donor can receive.

Many supporters also send us letters confirming their intention to make a bequest to the ATS. Besides ensuring that your wishes will be carried out, the bequest commitment letter enables the Foundation to recognize your gift and to discuss designation of your gifts.
